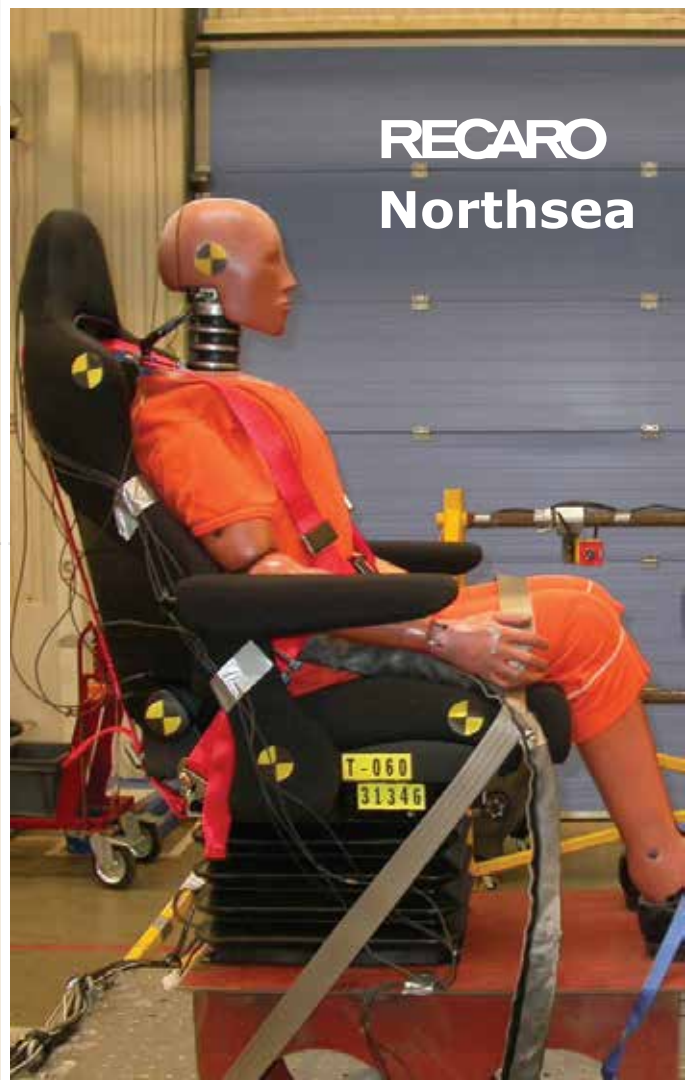
We tested the **Northsea** in 2005 and as the test was “only” 12g compared to the 22g that RECARO seats are routinely tested to, were confident that the IMO HCS 2000 Code (Annex 10) would be no problem.

A 12g acceleration is still very violent but as expected, the seat performed well under the test and **with no subsequent loss of functionality. VW**
